Other details:

- We'll be travelling on a Langley's Coach.
- We'll stay overnight at 'Willie Retreat' in the Marshes.
- A cooked Saturday dinner will be provided.
- There will stops at the Kookaburra Café (Window on the Wetlands Centre) in Warren to buy morning tea (Saturday) and lunch (Sunday).
- You'll need to bring your own morning tea (Saturday), Lunch (Saturday), Breakfast (Sunday) and Morning tea (Sunday). You can purchase a packed lunch from Warren on Saturday.
- The focus of the trip is on bird watching, so an interest in this is strongly recommended. Any level of bird watcher, from beginners to more experienced are welcome.
- You'll need to bring bird watching gear, outdoor clothing and shoes and a sleeping bag. There is an optional walk into a wetland for those interested – bring gumboots or old shoes and spare of trousers and socks for this.
